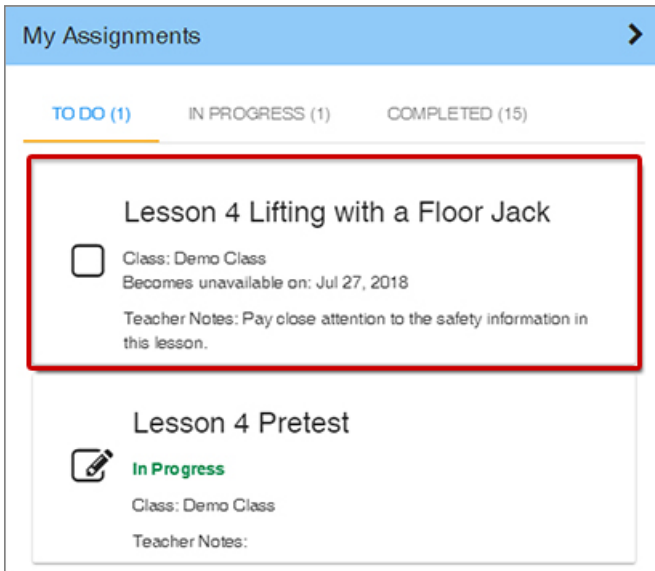

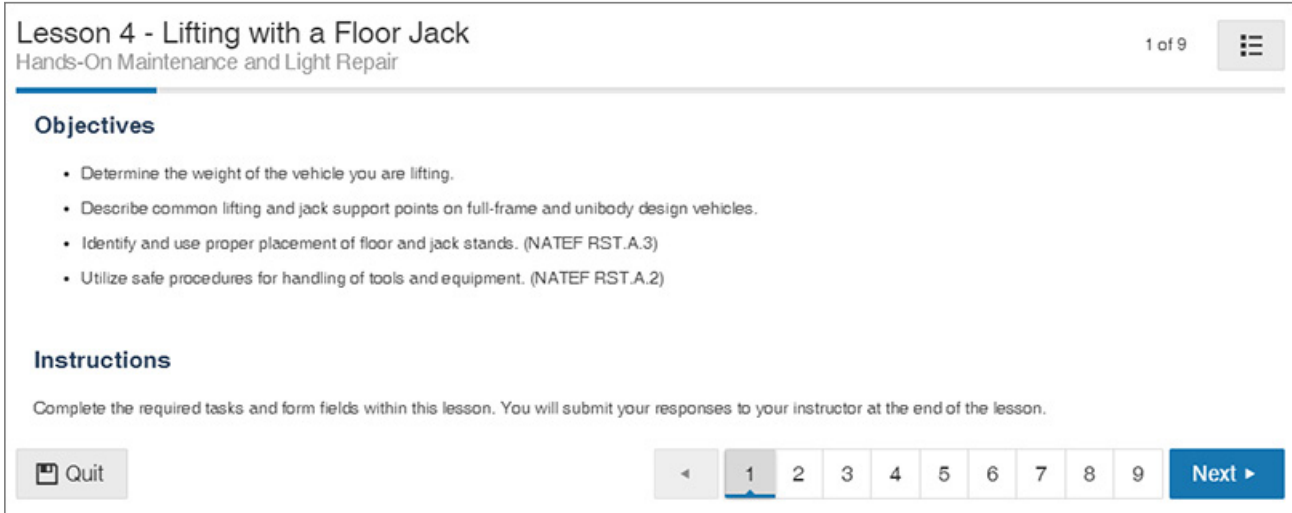
How do I open an assignment?
