

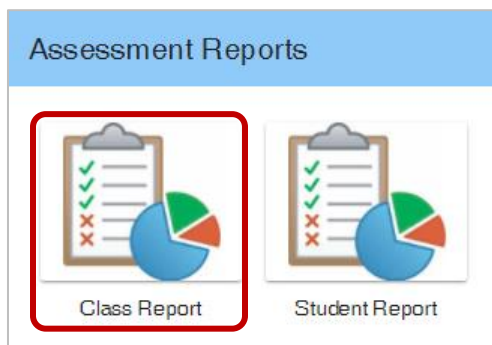

### How do I view Pretest and Posttest results?

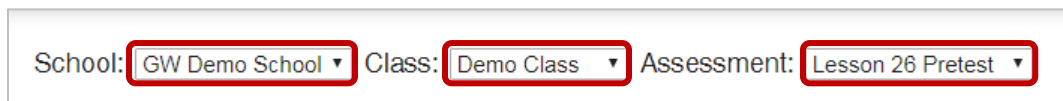
From the top of the Home page, select *Reports*.



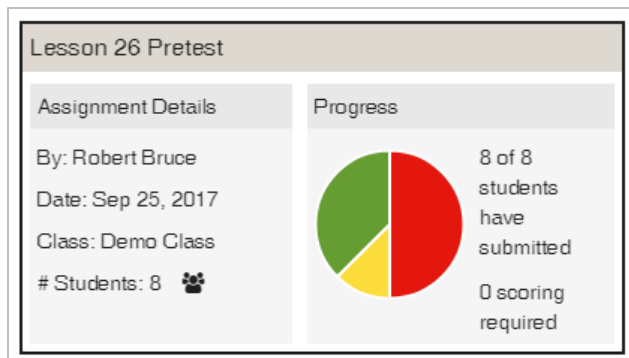
Select *Class Report*.



Use the drop-downs at the top of the page to select your *School*, *Class*, and the name of the *Assessment*.



Alternatively, you may select the Pretest or Posttest from the *My Assessments* panel on the Home page (if it is displayed there). This will take you directly to the Class Report page for the selected activity.



The *Class Report* page will display the results for all students in the class.

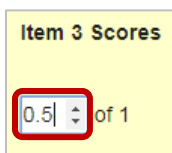

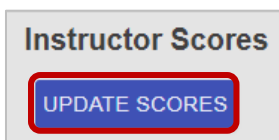

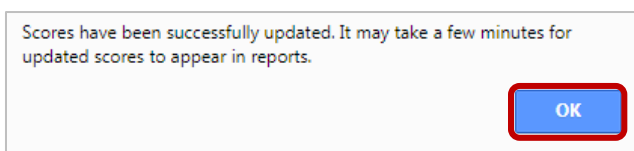


After modifying the score, select the *Update Scores* button at the top of the right-hand column.
